Kamens, E. Morales 96 Motion	Sheldon Johnson	Charged with two counts of first-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly fatally shot Collin Small inside an apartment on Summit Avenue on March 5, 2024, cut up his body, and tried to hide the remains.

Strout, N. Morales 96 COC	Emmanuel Awah Elias Afflada	Charged with Attempted Murder in the second-degree and additional charges. The defendants acting in concert, allegedly punched, kicked, and stabbed a man near East 182nd Street and the Grand Concourse in the Fordham Heights section after he walked past them and said Happy New Year on January 1, 2024.
Flanders, D. Yearwood TRP Motion	Isaiah Thompson	Charged with second-degree Assault and additional charges. The defendant allegedly slashed an MTA Train Conductor with a sharp object causing cuts to her face requiring stitches at the Whitlock Avenue station on June 10, 2025.
Birnbaum, D. Clancy 28 Motion	Khaleel Cooper	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly stabbed his girlfriend Tamara Rowe to death inside of 667 East 232nd Street in the Wakefield section on June 28, 2025.
Dolan, M. -- SCA Appearance	Norman Moore	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant, acting in concert, allegedly drove his son, co-defendant Devonte Moore and an apprehended teen to White Plains Road, where the teen shot and killed Fareed Adeyi in his car on October 7, 2025.
Namani, B. Yearwood TRP Appearance	Rahul Cuya, Terrence White, Richard Santiago	Charged with first-degree Murder, second-degree Murder, first-degree Arson, and additional charges. The defendants, acting in concert allegedly kidnapped Nikki Huang and Jesse Parrilla and shot them execution style on Shore Road and left their bodies in a burning car on May 16, 2022.
Miras, J. McCormack 22 Appearance	Sharief Bodden	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly beat Peter Forrest to death inside an ambulette parked near Hart Street and Castle Hill Avenue on January 13, 2025.

Taverna, R. Park 77 Possible Disposition	Timothy Bohler	Charged with first-degree Assault and additional charges. On January 24, 2025, the defendant allegedly swung a machete and cut off four fingers of a man who was defending his dog inside a bodega on East 178th Street.
Baughman, R. Busching 14 Appearance	Wendy Lora	Charged with third-degree Rape and additional charges. The defendant, a school guidance counselor, allegedly engaged in sex with a 16-year-old boy at various locations inside the school between September 2023 to October 2024.

Collins, T. Yearwood TRP Motion	Ahmet Gashi	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. After being ejected from a bar, the defendant allegedly ran over Kemal Kolenovic on December 31, 2006. The defendant fled to Kosovo and was extradited to the U.S. on December 13, 2024.
Kilcommons, M. Morales 96 COC	Dimas Cuadrado	Charged with second-degree Manslaughter and additional charges. The defendant, while allegedly intoxicated, drove through a red light, and struck another vehicle, killing the front passenger and injuring the driver near Randall Avenue and Castle Hill Avenues on November 16, 2024.
Collins, T. Morales 96 COC	Hector Ayalarivera	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly struck his roommate Oneil Gilkes on the head repeatedly inside 345 East 146 th Street in the Melrose section on March 4, 2025.

Ainis, M. Morales 96 Appearance	Jetsy Rodriguez	Charged with second-degree Manslaughter and additional charges. The defendant was allegedly speeding when she struck and killed Christian Castelan at East 172nd Street and Metcalf Avenue in the Soundview Section on July 3, 2022.
Dolan, M. Collins 19 COC	Terrell Loyd	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly shot and killed Laquai Dash on the grounds of P.S. 157 on March 7, 2025.

White, C. Steed 71 Motion	Dreshawn Lucas Waynol Recio	Charged with two counts of Attempted Murder and additional charges. The defendants acting in concert allegedly shot two boys, ages 12 and 13, inside a McDonalds on White Plains Road on July 16, 2024.
Birnbaum, D. Stone 27 Hearing	James Devore	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly stabbed his ex-girlfriend in 2005 leading to her death. He was indicted in 2024 after advancements in DNA technology linked him to her murder.
Browne, W. Stone 27 Sentencing	Lacon Brown	Pleaded guilty to second-degree Murder. The defendant shot his girlfriend Cindy Maxwell in front of her two girls, ages six and 11 inside 660 Arnow Avenue on August 23, 2023.
Dolan, M. -- SCA	Waldo Mejia	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly fatally stabbed 14- year-old Caleb Rijos at a bus stop by Alexander Avenue and 138th

Milanes, M. Goldberg 77 Appearance	Windella Sanderson Wells	The defendant allegedly posed as an attorney who could improve citizenship applications, taking \$73,000 from members of the Caribbean community between September 1, 2019, and May 1, 2023.
