Baughman, R. Stone 27 Appearance	Tajanhae Brown	Charged with Attempted Assault in the first degree, second-degree Assault, and additional charges. The defendant allegedly caused her young daughter to become ill by giving her an overdose of prescription medication to treat epilepsy she didn't have.

Snay. D. Bowen 17 Decision on motion	Jayvone Johnson	Charged with second-degree Rape and additional charges. The defendant was a teacher and basketball coach, and allegedly raped a 14-year-old student on December 23, 2024, at a motel.
Namani, B. Busching 14 Appearance	Rahul Cuya Richard Santiago	Charged with first-degree Murder, second-degree Murder, first-degree Arson, and additional charges. The defendants, acting in concert allegedly

		kidnapped Nikki Huang and Jesse Parrilla, shot them execution style, and left their bodies in a burning car on May 16, 2022.
<b>Naughton, M. Clancy</b> 28 <b>Decision on motion</b>	<b>Steven Davis</b> <b>Natasha Laing</b> <b>Manuel Lorenzo</b>	Charged with first-degree Promoting Prison Contraband and additional charges. The defendants allegedly conspired to bring in security tools, marijuana, and tobacco into Rikers Island. Davis, a NYC Department of Correction Officer, also allegedly stole nearly \$8,000 in pay for hours he did not work.
<b>Martin, M. McCormack</b> 22 <b>Appearance</b>	<b>Fode Niang</b>	Charged with Attempted Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly slashed a man with a box cutter on East 161st Street in the Melrose section on June 20, 2024.
<b>Miras, J. Clancy</b> 28 <b>Appearance</b>	<b>Jayden Rivera</b>	Charged with first-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly stabbed to death his father, his father's girlfriend, and their 5-year-old son inside an apartment at 674 East 138th Street in the Mott Haven section on November 26, 2023.

<b>Dicostanzo, N. Morales</b> 96 <b>DNA Results</b>	<b>Alfredo Trinidad</b> <b>Justin Herde</b>	Charged with Second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendants, acting in concert, allegedly shot, and killed William Alvarez on the D train at Grand Concourse and East 182nd Street on February 23, 2024.

<b>Doty, E. Hornstein 96 COC</b>	<b>James Dillon</b>	Charged with Attempted Murder in the second-degree and additional charges. The defendant allegedly struck three women with his car, severely injuring two of them in front of 3233 East Tremont Avenue in the Schuylerville section on July 20, 2025.
<b>Wichman, T. Stone 27 COC</b>	<b>Lissette Soto-Domenech</b>	Charged with first-degree Assault, first-degree Reckless Endangerment, and related charges. The defendant allegedly starved her twin sons and kept them virtually housebound for years.
<b>Dolan, M. -- SCA 730 hearing</b>	<b>Waldo Mejia</b>	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly fatally stabbed 14- year-old Caleb Rijos at a bus stop by Alexander Avenue and 138th Street in the Mott Haven Section on January 10, 2025.

<b>ADA Judge Part # Status</b>	<b>Defendant Name</b>	<b>Case Details</b>
<b>Irace, P. Morales 96 Decision on motion/COC</b>	<b>Marck Urena Fernandez</b>	Charged with second-degree Manslaughter and additional charges. On April 12, 2024, the defendant, while allegedly driving at excessive speed, allegedly struck, and killed Martina Sanchez Alcantara while she was crossing the street at E. 164th Street and the Grand Concourse.
<b>Goward, J. David 33 Trial</b>	<b>Peter Milatz</b>	Charged with Criminally Negligent Homicide and additional charges. The defendant allegedly failed to implement critical safety features, which led to an elevator collapse that killed his co-worker Joseph Rosa.

<b>ADA Judge Part # Status</b>	<b>Defendant Name</b>	<b>Case Details</b>
<b>Ambrosi, A. Steed 71 Possible Disposition</b>	<b>Charles Vilson Elizabeth Allen Marlon Laronde</b>	Charged with first-degree Criminal Sale of a Firearm and additional charges. The defendants acting in concert allegedly purchased guns from out-of-state, brought them to a Bronx autobody shop, and removed the serial numbers. Seventeen firearms were sold to an undercover police officer.
