Kamens, E. Lewis 70 Appearance	Brittany Ward Aaron Rene	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendants acting in concert with each other allegedly shot Marquis Lane on February 7, 2023, leading to his death. The shooting occurred near Park Avenue and E. 167th Street
Gattuso, J. Yearwood TRP Decision on Omnibus Motion	Samuel Calderon	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly entered his ex-girlfriend's 13th floor apartment at 3475 Bivona Street on January 24, 2026, to steal her kitchen stove. The defendant allegedly disconnected the stove causing a gas leak which led to an explosion that killed tenant Ronald McCallister.

Suminski, G. Clancy 28 Appearance	Muhammad Aadil Ronei Harris	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendants acting in concert, allegedly killed and dismembered Lutalo Henderson after a dispute and transported his remains in a shopping cart on a Metro North train to Yonkers sometime between July 27 and August 5, 2024.

Dolan, M. Yearwood TRP Result of 730 Examination	Christopher Hunt	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant is accused of fatally stabbing Eric Worell in an unprovoked attack inside a homeless shelter on Landing Road on May 26, 2024.
Vega, J. Morales 96 Appearance	Kayjon Yizar	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant is accused of fatally stabbing Arkmayer Davis outside a Red Cross shelter in the Mount Hope section on December 24, 2024.
Vega, J. Lewis 70 Appearance	Lillibeth Vasquez	Charged with second-degree Murder and first-degree Manslaughter. On November 26, 2023, near Intervale Avenue and Fox Street in the Longwood section, the defendant allegedly crashed her vehicle into Robert Jimenez, who was on a scooter, causing his death.
Kamens, E. Hornstein 96 Appearance	Sheldon Johnson	Charged with two counts of first-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly fatally shot Collin Small inside an apartment on Summit Avenue on March 5, 2024, cut up his body, and tried to hide the remains.
Lindston, R. Lewis 70 Decision on Motions	Christopher Gonzalez	Charged with Attempted Murder in the second-degree and additional charges in connection with two separate shootings. On April 7, 2025, the defendant allegedly fired four shots into an occupied home in

		the East Tremont section. Then on June 7, 2025, while allegedly engaged in a gunfight with an unidentified man, the defendant allegedly fired his weapon multiple times.

Dolan, M. Goldsmith SCA Appearance	Waldo Mejia	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant allegedly fatally stabbed 14-year-old Caleb Rijos at a bus stop by Alexander Avenue and 138th Street in the Mott Haven section on January 10, 2025.
Seidenberg, D. Rodriguez 77 Possible Disposition	Juan Valoy	Charged with Burglary, Grand Larceny and Scheme to Defraud. The defendant, allegedly posing as a real estate agent, took more than \$75,000 from 18 victims by taking payments from them to rent apartments that he was not authorized to rent out.

Dolan, M. Roberts 32 Decision on Motions	Norman Moore	Charged with second-degree Murder and additional charges. The defendant, acting in concert, allegedly drove his son, co-defendant Devonte Moore, and a teen to White Plains Road, where the teen allegedly shot and killed Fareed Adeyi in his car on October 7, 2025.
