Namani, B. Busching 14 Jury Selection	Rahul Cuya Richard Santiago Terence White	Charged with first-degree Murder, second-degree Murder, first-degree Arson, and additional charges. The defendants, acting in concert allegedly kidnapped Nikki Huang and Jesse Parrilla, shot them execution style, and left their bodies in a burning car on Shore Road on May 16, 2022.
McGraw, J. Collins 19 Closing Arguments	Ernest Williams	Charged with second-degree Murder and first-degree Manslaughter. The defendant, acting in concert with another, allegedly shot and killed Corey Allen on Tillotson Avenue in the early morning hours of September 4, 2021.

Mairs, M. Yearwood TRP Appearance	Stephanie Castillo	Charged with first-degree Murder, second-degree Murder and Manslaughter. The defendant, after giving birth to twin boys, allegedly committed a series of actions that caused their deaths on November 9, 2020.
McHale, S. Bowen 17 Appearance	Nicholas DeJesus	Charged with first-degree Rape and additional charges. The defendant allegedly punched and raped a 33-year-old woman as she was walking on Broadway in the Kingsbridge section on September 16, 2025.
McGraw, J. Mitchell 11 Appearance	Bryan Ciprian Jose Guadalupe	Charged with second-degree Murder and Robbery. The defendants acting in concert allegedly robbed Edgar Acevedo near E. Kingsbridge Road and Grand Concourse on February 18, 2024. Less than 60 minutes later Acevedo suffered a fatal heart attack at the police station house.
Scaccia, C. Collins 19 Hearing	Vernon Gowdy	Charged with second-degree Murder and Manslaughter. Defendant is accused of fatally stabbing Kenneth Fair on West Fordham Road during the afternoon of July 30, 2022.

Gattuso, J. Yearwood TRP SCA	Michael Foster	Charged with second-degree Murder and Manslaughter. The defendant is accused of fatally shooting his niece, Julia Anderson, near Murdock Avenue and Nereid Avenue on the evening of July 13, 2026.
Wichman, T. Stone 27 People's COC/Defense Motions	Lissette Soto-Domenech	Charged with first-degree Assault, first-degree Reckless Endangerment, and related charges. The defendant allegedly starved her twin sons and kept them virtually housebound for years.

Gibson, T. Isales 33 Post Conviction Hearing	Omar Habib	On August 13, 2026, the defendant, a former NYPD officer was convicted of second-degree Strangulation, third-degree Assault and Unlawful methods of Restraint. On July 29, 2023, then-Officer Habib applied a prohibited chokehold on a subject, causing the man to lose consciousness.
Collins, T. Hornstein 96 Decision on Motions	Malik Douglas	Charged with second-degree Murder, and first-degree Manslaughter. Acting in concert with another, the defendant is accused of fatally shooting 46-year-old Denver Bernard on E. 216 th Street and Laconia Avenue on the morning of September 9, 2024.

ADA Judge Part # Status	Defendant Name	Case Details
Horzempa, D. Busching 14 Appearance	Beyonce Johnson Saleh Ceesay	Charged with second-degree Murder, and first-degree Manslaughter. Acting in concert, the defendants are accused of fatally stabbing Shashamanie Thomson inside the elevator of the Ogden Avenue apartment building in which they lived on December 27, 2025.
Vega, J. Lewis 70 Appearance	Lillibeth Vasquez	Charged with second-degree Murder and first-degree Manslaughter. The defendant is accused of causing the death of Robert Jiminez by deliberately driving her car into him as he was driving a scooter near Intervale Avenue and Fox Street on November 26, 2023.
