**BRONX MAN INDICTED FOR MURDER IN FATAL STABBING
OF MAN AFTER ARGUMENT
Victim Stabbed Multiple Times**

Bronx District Attorney Darcel D. Clark today announced that a Bronx man has been indicted on second-degree Murder and other related charges for allegedly stabbing a man to death after an argument.

District Attorney Clark said, “This defendant allegedly stabbed the victim multiple times following a dispute. The victim lay mortally wounded on the street, before paramedics were able to arrive at the scene.”

District Attorney Clark said the defendant, Antonio Jackson, 31, of Bryant Avenue, the Bronx, was arraigned today on second-degree Murder, first-degree Manslaughter and fourth-degree Criminal Possession of a Weapon, before Bronx Supreme Court Justice Pamela Goldsmith. Remand is continued. He is due back in court on May 29, 2026.

According to the investigation, at approximately 6:30 p.m. on January 9, 2026, Aaron Carpenter, 34, knocked on the defendant’s apartment door and the two men began to argue. As Carpenter was leaving, Jackson allegedly grabbed a 12-inch kitchen knife, pursued him to the lobby, and continued arguing. Carpenter exited the building. Then, the defendant allegedly attacked him from behind. Surveillance video shows the victim crawling away from the defendant onto the street and collapsing between two parked cars. He was rushed to St. Barnabas Hospital and pronounced dead shortly afterwards. Police arrested Jackson near the scene about an hour later.

The case is being prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Joseph Gattuso of the Homicide Bureau, under the supervision of Burim Namani, Deputy Chief of the Homicide Bureau, Christine Scaccia, Chief of the Homicide Bureau, and under the overall supervision of James Brennan, Deputy Chief of Trial Division and Terry Gottlieb, Chief of Trial Division.
