AWARENESS DAY WITH “RECLAIM THE BLOCK” FLOWER
PLANTING AT BEAN MORRIS GARDEN**

Tomorrow, Friday, June 5, in recognition of Gun Violence Awareness Day, the Bronx District Attorney’s Office will host a violence prevention beautification project, “Reclaim the Block,” at Bean Morris Garden. Community members will clean the park and plant annual and perennial orange flowers in honor of fatal shooting victims from the Fordham neighborhood.

Friends, families, and community partners affected by gun violence will speak about their experiences and the hope for a safer, more peaceful future.

The event will begin at 11:30 a.m. inside the Bean Morris Garden at 2096 Morris Avenue, between East 181st Street and Burnside Avenue.

District Attorney Clark will be joined by Bronx Parks Commissioner Jessenia Aponte, cure violence groups and other organizations.
